Call Committee Update

The Our Call Committee met Wednesday, September 20, to prepare an interview question plan based on our congregation's survey results. A Mock Interview is scheduled 5:00-7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 27 with Pastor Tina Crog, who recently went through the call process, including interviews. She accepted her call to St. Jacob Lutheran Church, Massillon, Ohio. We are grateful to Pastor Crog for her willingness to help our Call Committee prepare for actual candidate interviews.

With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, Pastor Mitch Phillips, Assistant to our Northeastern Ohio Synod Bishop Barbins, is reviewing rostered ministers' mobility papers. He is contacting candidates who seem to have the best gifts for our faith community, as indicated by our survey results and our Ministry Site Profile. He projected that we will begin interviewing candidates in October.

Please note that, although we can share the details about the Mock Interview, we will not be able to do so regarding actual interviews. Call Committee members are committed to absolute confidentiality about who, when and where as candidates are interviewed. This is largely to protect their current congregation and their ministry with them. We ask for your help in maintaining this important commitment.

We are *calling* a pastor, which is different than *hiring* a candidate. All involved in the call process must be aware of the work of the Holy Spirit, as we continue to discern what God is working out for us. To do otherwise is to risk that we will not have the pastor our congregation needs at this time. Continue to be united in prayer, asking for God's direction and perfect timing. Thank you!

We are planning to participate with Bay United Methodist again this year. The week that the trip will happen next year is 6/16 through 6/22. There are a few changes that impact who can go on the ASP trip and the cost. First, ASP has decided that a 7th or 8th grader (meaning 6th grade going into 7th or 7th grade going into 8th) can go on the trip if a parent is going along. That will open some opportunities for some youth. Second, we are discussing a reduction in the cost if a youth commits early, I am not sure what that reduction might be for sure but will find out more details in the weeks ahead.
