Call Committee Update

Il Our Call Committee met October 4 to refine our First Interview plan based on our September 27 Mock Interview experience. We are grateful to Pastor Tina Crog, pastor of St. Jacob Lutheran Church, Massillon, Ohio, for her willingness to help us prepare for actual candidate interviews. Via a Zoom practice interview, Pastor Tina shared many insights and ideas for the good of our actual interviews, our next pastor and our congregation.

One such idea generated by Pastor Tina was to prepare a pictorial directory of our members to help our new pastor get to know us. Less than 40 hours later, our Office Administrator, Heather sent an email asking that we send pictures to the church office to prepare such a directory. No member of the Call Committee spoke to Heather about doing so. If there are any doubts that the Holy Spirit is involved in the Call Process, please savor this account.

Again, Pastor Mitch Phillips, Assistant to our Bishop, is reviewing rostered ministers' mobility papers and contacting candidates who seem to have the best gifts for our faith community. He says that there are many factors that make our church a desirable Call. Pastor Mitch projects that we will begin interviewing candidates soon.

Although the Call Committee can share details of the Mock Interview, the Who, When and Where of actual clergy candidates must be held in absolute confidentiality to protect the pastor, their current congregation and their pastor's ministry with them. Please help the Call Committee in maintaining this important commitment.

Also note, we are *calling* a pastor, which is different than *hiring* a candidate. We must be aware of the

work of the Holy Spirit, as we continue to discern what God is working out for us. To do otherwise is to risk that we will not have the pastor our congregation needs at this time.
